We invite all the people interested in data visualization and issues related to collaborative economy to show their creativity.

The participants should propose visualizations, which allow to identify new relations or likely explanations of collaborative economy with the data created within the project P2Pvalue.

It will be a space to show your skills and give visibility to your work in an international event in the framework of an European project.

The main goal is to create visualizations to identify relations and explanations among diverse types of cases of Collaborative Economy.

## Criteria of Evaluation

1. New explanations (relations) that supply the visualization-40%
2. The use of P2Pvalue databases and other sources. -20%

3. The replicability of the visualization. -20%
4. The likely interactivity with the data-20%

The contest will have five winners. The price to distribute is 1,000€. The best five visualizations will be awarded. Each team or individual can only receive one prize. The winners will be announced from 12:30 p.m. on March 13<sup>th</sup> the last day of the event [Procomuns](#) in Barcelona.

Each team (or individual) will receive the net amount of the prize by bank transfer within 45 days of the conclusion of the awards ceremony. To this end the winners will provide their bank details to the organization for the payment.

**Terms and conditions**

The registration and participation on the Datathon necessarily implies full and unconditional acceptance of the terms and conditions in these regulatory bases and the interpretation of them by the organizers.

Participants also accept the decisions of the organizers and the jury with the selection of contestants and winners of the contests. No P2P value member may participate in the contest or be rewarded (they can be members of the Jury).

Participants expressly authorize the organization and the project P2Pvalue to use visualizations for non-commercial and educational purposes related to the dissemination of this contest and in general the collaborative economy through any media that its members may consider appropriate, including social networks and profiles on Facebook and Twitter or any other media and support always recognizing authorship of the creators, without this resulting in any adicional economic consideration. The deadline for such approval shall be for an unlimited period. To this end, individuals or teams who choose to participate accept this assignment, which does not mean losing recognition as authors.

The data provided for the assessment and application for participation in this contest will become part of a file of the organizers, as established in the Organic Spanish Law on Protection of Personal Data 15/1999 of 13 December (LOPD) and the Spanish Royal Decree 1720/2007
